SPECIAL NOTICE

It must be strictly observed that no limbering up will be allowed on the actual course. Limbering up should take place within area surrounded by course. Disciplinary action may be taken against anyone who disobeys this order.

SPIKES MUST NOT BE WORN IN DRESSING ROOMS, and mud should be removed from footwear before entering the dressing room.

A bell will be rung before the start of the Championship race after which the competitors must immediately proceed to the starting point and any competitor not forward for the Official Start will be disqualified.

In the Race numbers must be worn on **FRONT AND BACK** of vests and pinned at either side of the number and under no circumstances must the number be defaced or reduced in size.

No individual, other than the Officials appointed to manage the event, and competitors actually engaged in the event, shall be allowed over or on the course of the Championship race.

Clubs must declare names of runners comprising team half an hour before the advertised time of the start of the race and competitors must compete in the order so declared.

Entries for team events must show the colours of the club's vest and a **VEST OF THESE COLOURS MUST BE WORN** by all members of the team while competing.

- 3 The Associate Members will elect one of their number to sit on General Committee with the rights and privileges of other General Committee Members. This election will take place at the Annual General Meeting.

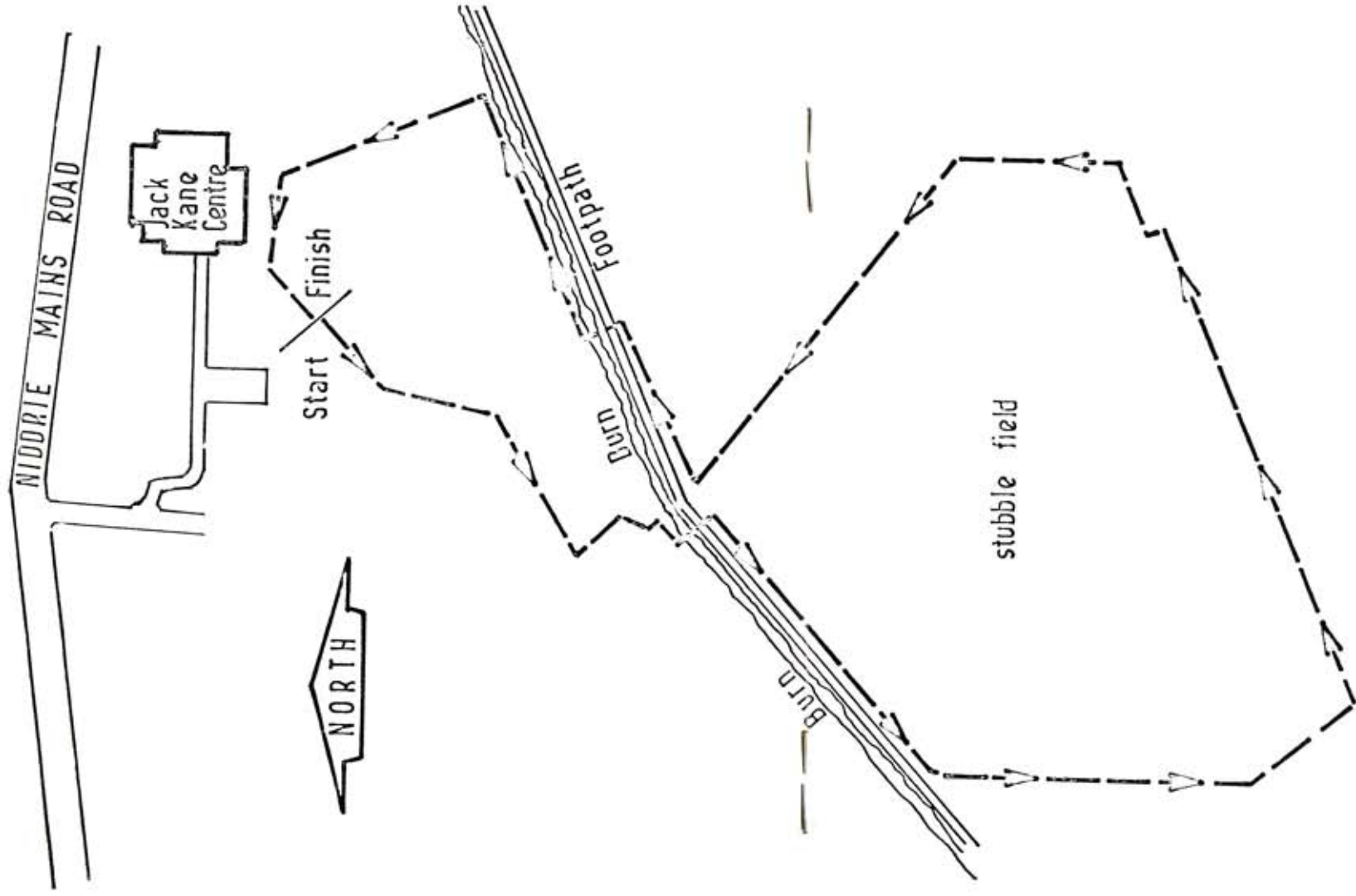
