Andrew Wright and Stan Mackenzie, with the next fastest legs, kept the yellow and maroon vests ahead, although Pride's comeback provided much excitement for spectators on an excellent course for both spectators and athletes.

Ann Smart set Inverness off on another repeat Inverness victory as they beat their sole opponents, Moray Road Runners, in the women's race.

women's race. Inverness, as in 1998, made it a female double with victory in the girls' race, Mhari Spence being particularly impressive on the under-15 stage.

The boys' trophy changed hands, holders BP Black Isle failing to catch Forres Harriers in another exciting finish. After Mark Mitchell and Kyle Hay had set up a lead for Forres, junior international 3,000m runner Craig Poole pulled 47 seconds back on John Mitchell who, sensing danger behind, had pulled away in the final 200m to maintain an 8-second cushion.
