SCOTTISH NORTHERN DISTRICT RELAY CHAMPIONSHIPS

Keith SCOTTISH mountain running international Graeme Bartlett anchored Forres Harriers to their first senior men's title for more than a decade while defending champions Keith and District had to settle for second, Fraser Clyne reports.

Bartlett, who was in the last Forres squad to win, in 1992, recorded the joint fastest individual lap time of the day when completing the 4km circuit in 12:02

Scottish U17 champion Willie Duncan equalled Bartlett's time when putting a non-counting guest select team in the lead on the opening circuit while Jeremy Whittet gave defending champions Keith and District a narrow lead over Paul Rogan of Forres

Brian Law then put Forres into pole position on the second leg with Keith and District slipping 31 seconds behind. Dave Adam held the Forres' lead on the third stage although Keith's Mike Stewart reduced the

deficit to six seconds Bartlett's final leg performance proved too strong for Keith veteran Ross Arbuckle,, who nevertheless produced the third best time of the

day. The Moray Road Runners trio of Jennifer Newman, Dawn Hardie and Jane Barker led from start to finish to win the women's title for the first time since 1996. Barker recorded the fastest lap time of the day by a wide

margin. Moray also won the male and female young athletes' races. Connor Cowie, Steven Houston and Steven Raeburn took top spot in the boys' competition. Laura Sharp, Rachel Pirie and Jennifer Houston won the girls' event - but they had no

opposition.

North athletics officials will be concerned by the poor turnout. Aside from the girls' race, there were just three boys' teams, three women's teams and six men's sides taking part
