

BELLAHOUSTON TAKE DOUBLE HONOURS

HIGH pointages in both District Junior cross-country championships held on Saturday reflected the open nature of the contest.

The Midlands event, at Hamilton Racecourse, was won by Bellahouston, whose aggregate of 93 points enabled them to beat Victoria Park by 12 points, while at Johnstone, the Greenock clubs, Glenpark and Wellpark, occupied the leading south-west positions with 102 and 127 points respectively.

The Midlands race was a repetition of the Renfrewshire Championship in both team and individual results, for Tom Lamb, Bellahouston, proved an easy winner. At the finish he had 170 yards to spare from G. Porteous, Maryhill, who furnished the biggest surprise by finishing second. His more fancied clubmate, A. T. Peters, retired before the finish with an injured ankle.

LIVINGSTONE'S SUCCESS

At half-distance in the Johnstone race, it appeared that James Barr, Beith, might redeem his former failure by winning the South-Western title. He was no match, however, for H. Livingstone, the Kilmarnock champion, over the last three miles. Livingstone eventually won by 70 yards from J. Thomson, Glenpark, who had moved up to beat Barr for second place.

Glenpark were well ahead in the team race at half-way, and although slipping back slightly, the winners maintained a good margin to the end.

Glasgow University proved much too strong for their Aberdeen rivals at Garscadden, and won both first and second team races. J. N. Lapraik revealed his best form to win the senior seven-miles event by 350 yards from J. D. Binning. Details:—
