BRITISH ultra-distance international Alan Reid won the senior men's title for the fifth time in 11 years but the much-travelled youngsters from the Hebridean islands of Stornoway and North Uist grabbed the spotlight with a series of medal winning performances, Fraser Clyne reports.

Reid took full advantage of the absence of three-time previous winner Simon Pride, who missed the event because he was competing in the Great South Run in Portsmouth as part of his preparations for January's Dubai

marathon.

Reid, who won the first of his titles in 1989, finished over 100m ahead of Andrew Wright. Ross Arbuckle was a further 80m behind when collecting bronze for the third year in a row.

Wright led Inverness Harriers to their first team title since 1993, thereby bringing an end to Keith & District AC's five-year domination of the competition.

Stan MacKenzie (fifth), Eric Riddle (sixth), Mark MacLeod (17th), Steve Worsley (20th) and Brian MacKenzie (24th) were the other scorers for the winning side.

Martin Flynn took the M40 title when placing seventh overall, just one place shead of UK 1500m, 5000m and 10,000m age group champion George

Forres Harriers enjoyed individual successes through Kyle Hay and Mark Mitchell in the U15 and U13 boys' races respectively, while Nairn's Donald MacAulay won the U17 title. BP Black lale scooped all three boys age group team titles.
