## S.-W. DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIPS.

The first of the three junior championships promoted each season by the National Cross-Country Union of Scotland took place on Saturday at Eglinton Castle, near Irvine. This was that pertaining to the South-Western District, which comprises the counties of Ayr and Renfrew. Two titles were involved—team and individual—and, as was the case last year, the honours went to Ayrshire club. There was an entry of twelve clubs, each being represented by twelve runners, of whom the first six counted in the team placings. The seven miles course was laid around the old castle, and consisted of two laps of  $3\frac{1}{2}$  miles each, the going being chiefly on grass.

Early in the race J. Addison, the Renfrewshire champion, who was favourite for individual honours, came down heavily at a fence, and thereafter he never got on terms with the leaders. There was only one Renfrewshire runner in the first dozen to finish, and much the same state of affairs prevailed in the team race, where the first three teams were all from Ayrshire.—Results:—
