- (b) League Race also for Senior Boys, Distance not less than 1½ or more than 2 Miles under E.D.C.C. League Rules except that the first four runners in each team count in the scoring.
- (c) League Race also for Junior Boys. Distance not to exceed 1 Mile under E.D.C.C. League Rules except that the first three runners in each team count in the scoring. (This is being given a trial this season).
- (d) Train from Edinburgh 12.57.p.m. or Clubs to make their own arrangements.
- (e) Bus from Edinburgh.

Youths Section. 16 years of age or over but under 18 years of age on 1st October, 1965.

Senior Boys Section. 14 years of age or over but under 16 years of age on 1st October, 1965.

Junior Boys Section. 12 years of age or over but under 14 years of age on 1st October 1965 - to be run when the Senior Race is on.
