

EDINBURGH UNIVERSITY WIN SHIELD

KIRKCALDY PLACED SECOND

Edinburgh University won the Sandilands Shield in the concluding race of the Eastern District League held in Kirkcaldy on Saturday. The 'Varsity, firm favourites from the very start, won the league by a clear margin and finished with a total of 122 points. Kirkcaldy, by gaining first and second place in Saturday's race, finished second in the league with a total of 296 points, while Edinburgh Southern claimed third place with 297 points, one point behind Kirkcaldy.

Apart from a cold blustery wind, conditions were very favourable. Starting from Bennoch Bridge, the runners ran the 2-lap 6-mile course in less than an hour. Kirkcaldy Y.M.C.A. were prominent throughout and G. Rennie and W. Grieve, Kirkcaldy's foremost runners, capped a grand performance by finishing first and second respectively. G. Rennie returned a time of 38 mins. 50 secs, W. Grieve 39-13, while R. F. Wilby, Edinburgh University was third with a time of 39-30.
