BUPA Great Edinburgh International Cross Country/Scottish Inter-District Championships

Edinburgh: 05/01/13

1st (20 points) reducing by 1 to 20th (one point)

Scottish National Cross Country Championships

Falkirk: 23/02/13

Senior: 1st (40 points) reducing by 2 to 20th (two points)

£4000 of prize money is available to current scottishathletics members as follows: overall Grand Prix winners (male and female): £750; 2nd: £400; 3rd: £250; 4th: £150; 5th: £100;

6th: £75; 7th £50; 8th £40; 9th £30; 10th £20

In the event of a tie on points for 1^{st} place, the head-to-head record between senior athletes in the senior Scottish National Cross Country Championships (Falkirk, 23 Feb 2013) will determine the placing.
